

Gesso – Tag 1
Stamping in to Gesso

1. Brush a thick layer of gesso on to a portion of the tag.
2. Stamp image in to wet gesso, let dry.
3. Paint with a coat of acrylic paint and wipe off excess paint.
4. Brush a layer of gesso around the exterior of the key image, let dry.
5. Mix gesso together with acrylic paint. Brush on over the exposed gesso layer.
6. Allow to dry slightly. Add water droplets and leave on the surface for approximately one minute.
7. Wipe dry.

Gesso – Tag 3
Gesso Under and Over Acrylic Paint

1. Paint surface with gesso, let dry.
2. Paint over with acrylic paint, spritz with water and wipe off excess paint.
3. Use gesso to paint the surface of a red rubber stamp image and stamp over the top of the gesso/acrylic paint layers.
4. Distress further by using an ink blending tool together with Distress Ink. Heat set.

Gesso – Tag 2
Stamping with Gesso

1. Brush gesso on to the surface of a red rubber stamp image and stamp image. Let gesso dry.
2. Paint a coat of acrylic paint over the top and let it dry.
3. For a different look spritz with water and wipe off excess paint.
4. Add an additional layer of gesso around the key image covering a portion of the acrylic paint, let dry.
5. Paint with a watery layer of acrylic paint, wipe off excess.
6. Mist red rubber stamp, lightly press painted image to surface, remove and wipe dry.
